Funding for 10 hours TA support to: - allow for smaller group working within class -to take out pupils for small group and 1:1 focus on basic skills	£2250	Progress is accelerated for pupils over the year allowing eligible pupils to achieve age related expectations
Purchase of Sumdog for all pupils	£100	Providing pupils access to software to support learning outside school in both numeracy and literacy by providing a secure log-in per pupil. Attainment and confidence in maths and literacy is improved
Funding for TA and outdoor activity leader to enable Forest school sessions for whole school. Sessions develop self-esteem and team working for eligible pupils. (4 hours)	£900	Eligible pupils are motivated, have raised self esteem and develop social skills through the opportunity to take part in an enhanced curriculum. Gross and fine motor skills are improved which further impacts on attainment.
Funding for GTA for 1 hour per week for school baking session	£359	PP child has the opportunity to develop broad range of life skills as part of curriculum.
Purchase of phonetically coded reading books to provide appropriate resources for pupils. Read Write Inc	£200	Progress in reading is accelerated and gaps are closed.
Purchase of Numicon to support maths teaching.	£120	Providing pupils with kinaesthetic support for learning in mathematics
Bewerley Park – outdoor adventure activities	£95 £144 (Additional GTA cover during sessions)	Children are motivated and develop a broad range of skills through the opportunity to take part in an enhanced curriculum.
Subsidising after a school clubs and educational visits	£300	Provide financial support to parent/carers and allow pupils to access a broad and balanced curriculum.
